



## WebEx installation instructions

1) Open the invitation e-mail and click on "Join"




Your default browser will show the following login page






2) Insert your name and e-mail address in the fields on the right area and click "Join as Guest":




- 3) If you are using **Google Chrome** as your default browser, please follow the steps below:
  - a) Click on the "Add WebEx to Chrome" button






b) Add the Cisco WebEx Extension, by clicking on the *Add* button on the window popup




c) Save the Cisco\_WebEx\_Add-On.exe file on your computer






d) Click on the file on the bottom of the page to open it and then click on the *Run* button




- 4) If you are using **Internet Explorer** as your default browser, please follow the steps below:
  - a) In order to run the application, you need an up-to-date version of Java. If your java version is old or not working, you will see the following message:





- b) Click on "Downoad and install Java"
- c) Refresh the login page
- d) Install the WebEx Component









If the WebEx application is not starting, this is probably due to the **Active Protection Mode** (it must be turned OFF) . In order to turn off the Internet Explorer Protection Mode, click on the *Tools* Menu of the browser and choose Internet Options. Uncheck the box from the "Security" Tab, and click "Apply" and "Ok".



5) The WebEx window will be shown on your screen



6) Once the WebEx Window Meeting is loaded, click on the "Start my video" button





7) The icon camera must be green in order to show your video. If not, click on it.
